#### I. Approval of Minutes

- June 13, 2024, Regular meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

#### II. Chairman's Report

- Review of Approved Projects:
  - i. Golf Course rules updates, approved, and implemented.
  - ii. Cart path entrance signs to the golf course are installed.
  - iii. Driving Range leveled and sodded.
  - iv. Hole sequence change: To be implemented at re-opening of course after October closure. New monument plaques should be ready by then along with new scorecards and handicap allocations.
  - v. Tree plan approved by POA board, some trees have been removed. Approximately a dozen trees to be planted in the fall.
  - vi. Monarch butterfly habitat; approximately 200 milkweed plants are being raised to plant in Drought Tolerant area.
  - vii. Bunker plan to be presented at September meeting.

#### III. Golf Course Superintendent's Report: Mark Louder

Driving range is complete.

##### • Greens

- i. The H.O.C. is at .125"
- ii. A preventative fungicide program is in place.
  - Have begun fungicide app's for Summer Disease Prevention.
- iii. PGR's are being applied on a weekly basis.
- iv. Foliar fertilizer is applied on a weekly basis.
- v. Wetting agents are applied on a monthly basis.

##### • Tees

- i. The H.O.C. has been lowered from .600" to .500"
  - This will help to stimulate the bermudagrass.
- ii. Foliar N and Fe applications are made monthly.
  - This will also help to stimulate the bermudagrass.

iii. Divots are filled and teeing locations are moved daily.

iv. Par 3 tees and thin areas are top dressed as needed.

- **Fairways**

- i. The H.O.C. is at .500''

- ii. A selective herbicide has been applied to all fairways to aid in the transition from cool season to warm season turf.

- iii. Foliar fertilizer along with a PGR are applied monthly.

- iv. Granular fertilizer applications are being performed every two weeks to increase bermudagrass density.

- **Roughs**

- i. The H.O.C. is at 1.75''

- ii. Broadleaf weeds are spot sprayed as needed.

- **Bunkers**

- i. Bunker edging has begun and is on rotation.

**IV. Board Liaison: Joe Kamashian**

- Waiting on test of existing sign to see if they can be re-poured.

**V. Golf Course Professional: Pat Kemball**

- Golf Course usage is down slightly
  - i. Will provide updated numbers as soon as I receive them from Pat.
