Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award. Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128

Improvement factor: 1.128

Forty Years Ago – December 1984 Joe Hill, President of the Men's Golf Club highlighted the Club's achievements during the year and thanked his Board for their service. One of Joe's highlights was the participation of the members in the sub-groups, not just Wednesday golf. In today's world that would be the After Lunch Bunch, Over the Hill Gang, Friday Red Shirts and Monday Blue Shirts. etc. These groups provide additional opportunities for members to play golf and socialize in a less formal setting than Wednesday's. It was also reported that the recent "Tree Tournament" (Beautification Tournament), with a full field of 144 players, generated enough revenue to purchase 72, fifteen-gallon trees for the golf course. I wonder how many of them are still in place and where? Construction of today's Clubhouse was scheduled to begin in the coming year, 1985, and the restrooms on today's holes #5 and #15 were under construction. New tee markers had just been installed on the golf course. a bit of Deja Vu.

Thirty Years Ago – December 1994 It appears from the December 1994 Bulletin that things were not so well at the golf course. Concerns about the condition of the golf course were being expressed. The Green Committee reported to the golfers that *"The wheels have started to move to alleviate these concerns. Sand has been delivered to help our bunkers. Bare spots are being worked over. Mowing will be done so play will be speeded up".* An ad-hoc committee of five was established to approach the Green Committee with specifics on the condition of the golf course *and proposed solutions.* (Don't just complain, suggest solutions). The CLMGC Board approved \$1,893 for the Tuesday Work Group to purchase 200 railroad ties for installation on the golf course. (I think they are all gone 30 years later). Current members Chuck Hawley and Bob Stinson were listed as winners in After Lunch Bunch games the previous month. Some things never change. The Women's Golf Club reported that it had 199 members. Current CLWGC member Joanna Spiller was Handicap Chair of the CLWGC. She's like a *Die Hard Bunny*, she just keeps going and going and going. Go get'em Joanna.


Twenty Years Ago – December 2004 Over the course of ten years things at the golf course seemed to have improved. Membership in the CLMGC was 493, which included new member *Bob Jacobson*, your current Bulletin Editor, and Dudley Thompson was the Handicap Director, another *Die Hard Bunny*. For the third year in a row, Canyon Lake won the Temecula Valley League Championship and will get to retain the trophy. It looks like it took him twenty years to get there, but 2004 Green Committee member Jon Keigwin is now the 2024 Green Committee Chairman. He's starting to approach *Die Hard Bunny* status. Current members Joe Kamashian, Barry Talbot, Fred Hemborg, Jim Lippen, Rich Tucker, Jim Musser, Dudley Thompson, Bob Pickard, Joe Washle, Steve Spaeth and Bob Stinson were all mentioned in the Bulletin as winners in the Wednesday Men's Golf Club game. CLWCG Membership Chair Alice Ramirez reported that their membership was now 203.

The CLAPPS (Canyon Lake Association of Past Presidents) have done many things over the years to help beautify the golf course and make your golfing experience the best it can be with the revenue generated by the annual Beautification Tournament. The street clock, benches, sand boxes and putting green expansion are just a few examples of how the revenue from the annual Beautification Tournament is invested in our golf course. Improvements don't have to always be sizable to be impactful. While the course was shut down for overseeding this year, pole-mounted shoe spike cleaners have been installed on the ball washers. During winter golf, it is not unusual for us to have wet rye grass clippings clogging up our golf shoe spikes. Now you can enjoy the convenience of cleaning your shoes on every tee box without having to wait until you reach the clubhouse. Be sure to mark April 26th on your calendar for the 2025 Beautification Tournament where you will be able to enjoy a game of golf knowing revenue generated will be going back into the golf course for improvements big and small. This year, during the shutdown, the CLAPPS also replaced all bronze hole plaques bearing the new Canyon Lake logo and reflecting the course's re-configuration. The next Beautification Tournament will also give participants an opportunity to place silent auction bids on the bronze hole plaques that were replaced. So, tell your friends and neighbors, who may live on a particular hole on the course or have a special memory like a Hole-in-One or Eagle, to come bid on a bronze plaque that would be a fitting reminder of fond memories on the Canyon Lake golf course.


